- If there is any way to make the subject matter less confusing, that would be helpful. But I think it's kind of the nature of the beast, especially when it comes to recursion. If there is a more humanly readable book on the subject out there, I think it would be a good idea to use that. This textbook is full of hard-to-read strings of mathematical symbols, with no plain-English translation, and very few examples that explain steps to solve the problems in detail. I would rather have paid for a book that makes the subject matter easier to understand than have this book for free.
