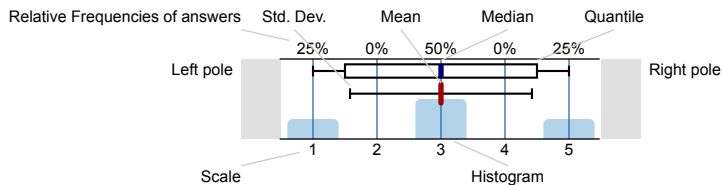

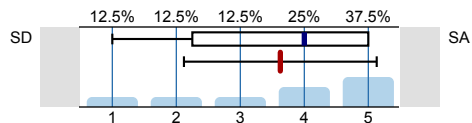

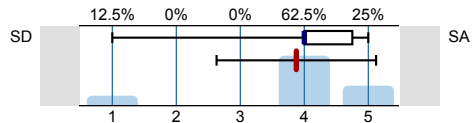

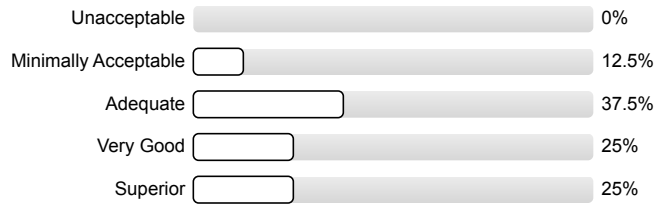

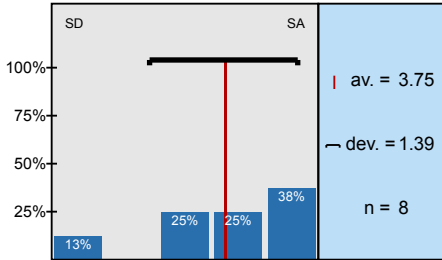

Histogram for scaled questions

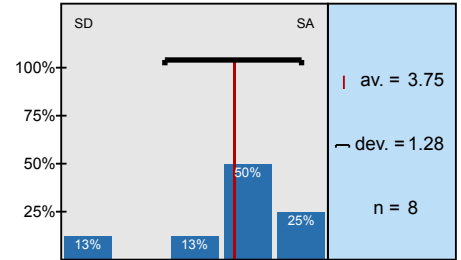
