







## Histogram for scaled questions



#### 3. Part B

- 3.11) What did your Instructor do to make this class a good learning experience for you?
- Answers questions very well.
- He created a safe learning environment that did not pressure students to participate constantly.
- He's very laidback and nice when it comes to teaching.
- Professor Mattman knows his shit. He's one of the first math teachers to actually interest me.
- The hw questions he chooses are perfect! You learn the topics really well
- The professor was very polite and was open to questions.
- This class was not a good learning experience for me. The instructor would lecture for the entire class and not explain the concepts in depth. There would be somewhat of an explanation but in a superficial manner.
- 3.12) What could your instructor do in the future to make this a better class?
- Have example questions of the topics we're learning during notes so we know what to expect on tests
- In the future, the instructor should hybridize the class where in conjunction with the lecture material, he should also go over examples from the book. It feels like you have to teach yourself all the curriculum in order to hopefully pass. Also, having someone who has taken the class before as a TA to explain the concepts would be good.
- Instead of presenting the material at a rapid pace, take time to fully explain just what is they are writing down.
- Material jumps from easy to difficult very abruptly, I feel that Prof. Mattman could have prepared the class for challenging topics in a better way.
- Maybe he could post lecture notes on Blackboard in order to portray small pointers that may otherwise be missed in class.
- Maybe slow down a bit on the harder topics especially when just starting out
- The weekly homework was pretty difficult and I often had no idea how to do certain problems (same with 95% of class). Often the problems were related to a topic we had learned but obscure enough so that it seemed foreign.
- 3.14) IMPORTANT: Please give at least one reason to justify your rating.
- Fantastic teacher! Learned lots but sometimes a bit boring
- He's teaching a difficult subject and still somehow making it interesting
- I feel like the class was okay. The material was very challenging, but the instructing was adequate to allow me to push for a high grade.
- It's very hard to lose track of what's going on in the class, and having only two days of class a week doesn't help.
- Overall great teacher, at times material could have been explained differently.
- The professor understands the material but should realize that students are beginning to learn it streamline lectures in a way that encourages people think that the material is not as complicated as it appears.
- This class is structured in a way where the student is supposed to do all the learning on his own time. Though the instructor does lecture I believe he is using his time inefficiently to teach the material covered in the class. As stated above, doing examples from the book would help a ton. He hands out a worksheet on Thursday but doesn't really explain the answers when he posts them on the board.
